

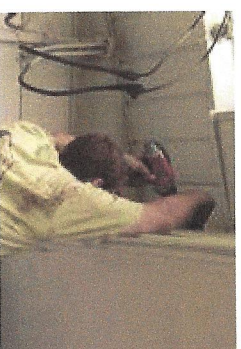
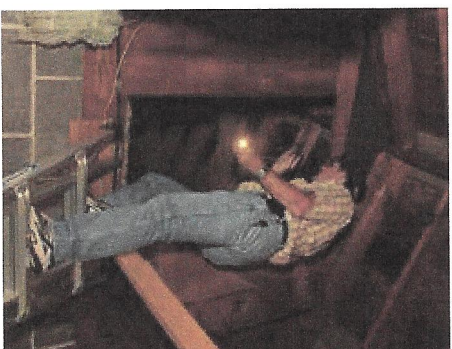
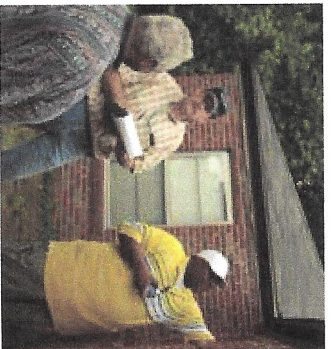
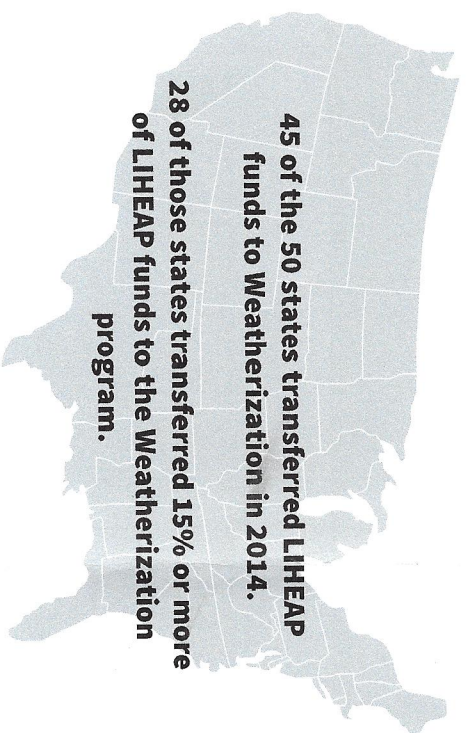
# Weatherization Benefits Missouri

Weatherization provides cost effective energy savings to Missouri families, delivers additional health and safety benefits, supports jobs, and creates a stable platform for additional investment in energy efficiency.

There are 18 agencies in Missouri currently administering the Weatherization program throughout the state.

On average, homes that have had Weatherization Services save **\$283** per year on their utility bill according to the U.S. Department of Energy.

An Ameren Missouri study of homes weatherized using the pre and post utilities usage, showed an average savings of **12%** per home weatherized.



Along with the energy efficiency benefits of the Weatherization Program, there is a health and safety aspect of the program.

One of the safety aspects is to address all unsafe gas heating appliances because of cracked heat exchange units.

Other safety aspects of the Weatherization program include repairing gas leaks and insuring a healthy indoor air quality in the home.

*Most Weatherization sub-grantees in Missouri still have a 1-2 year waiting list for weatherization services. Increased funding for Weatherization will reduce the wait time for many Missouri families.*

## NUMBERS TO KNOW

**1337**

The LIHEAP transfer to Weatherization for Program Year 2014/2015 in Missouri resulted in 1337 homes being weatherized that would not have been otherwise.

**\$378,371**

A total energy savings to these low-income Missouri families from the reduction of their utility bills is estimated at \$378,371... a savings that will continue year after year once the home has been weatherized.
